ROLL CALL – City Clerk – Councilman Frank Bryant, Councilwoman Lillian Sams, Councilwoman Dot Shealey, Chair Bill Goodge and Vice Chair Douglas Williamson. Mayor Dale Wiseman and City Attorney Will Sexton were absent. City Clerk/Administrator Mary Lou Hildreth was also present.

1. Public Hearings:

A. Proposed Millage Rate 2.00/\$26,851 Yearly Ad Valorem

Ms. Hildreth presented the recommended millage rate of 2.00 (a .25 increase) for Fiscal Year 24/25. She reminded the council that our expenses have gone up in all categories (i.e. insurance was \$9,000 per year 10 years ago and now it is almost \$23,000 due to the recent asset survey, audits have gone from \$15,000 to \$24,000, and regular costs from utilities to supplies have increased as well). She provided examples of residents TRIM notices reflecting the minimal impact of \$10 - \$20 more per year, and many less than that.

B. Proposed Budgets General Fund/Water Fund

Ms. Hildreth provided the Budget Summary for Fiscal Year 24/25 and pointed out that while it appears quite large, the majority of funds in revenue and expense are due to the many grants that are currently in process.
